

**MCGREGOR CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2016 5:00 P.M.**

The MCGREGOR CITY COUNCIL met in Special Session at 5:00 p.m. on **Wednesday, November 2, 2016** at city hall. Mayor Brooks presided with Council members Hallberg, Carroll, Echard, Halvorson, and Muehlbauer were in attendance.

Council reviewed a concern that had been sent to the city clerk regarding the intersection of Main St. and West Main near St. Mary's Catholic Church. Sander had asked the DOT if they had other options available rather than the left turn vehicles yield sign. They had only one suggestion which would be to place the stop sign on Main St. for west bound traffic and remove the stop sign from the 7th st. corner. This would impede semi traffic and create more congestion at the intersection. The crash history was provided by the DOT as well showing a low incident level. Sander stated that red flags could be added to the existing sign to perhaps bring more attention to the yield sign. Council agreed that they did not want to change the traffic flow and asked that the DOT be notified to add flags to the yield sign and continue to monitor the situation.

Hallberg moved, seconded by Echard to approve change order #6 for the FEMA Storm water control project in the amount of \$6,870.00. Roll call vote: Ayes – all. Motion carried.

Muehlbauer moved, seconded by Hallberg to approve change order #7 for the FEMA Storm water control project in the amount of \$64,615.73. Roll call vote: Ayes – all. Motion carried.

Echard moved, seconded by Muehlbauer to approve change order # 8 in the amount of \$6,700.00. Roll call vote: Ayes – all. Motion carried.

Carroll moved, seconded by Echard to approve HR Green engineering contract amendment #3 in the amount of \$13,000. Roll call vote: Ayes – all. Motion carried. Sander informed the mayor and council that the walk through of the project will take place in the next few days and close out will begin once all work has been completed.
